- It needs singable melodies, meaningful lyrics, and a theme appropriate for group singing.

You retain the rights to your song. Your submission releases FFC from product and all other liability and allows the use of all submitted information for contest promotional purposes.

Conductor/arranger/songwriter Chris Eastburn is the founding artistic director of the Family Folk Chorale, a multigenerational chorus, ages 3-80.

Recent performances featured songs by U2, Stevie Wonder, the Beatles, the Grateful Dead, Joni Mitchell, Carole King, Paul Simon, the Weavers, Bob Dylan, and more.

Collaborations with recent guest artists have included Oen Kennedy, Alistair Mook, Rani Arbo and daisy mayhem, Bill Staines, John Carter Cash, Seth Bernard and Mae Erlewine.
